

Thanks to FDH, MJ family to have new house

A Mulanje woman will soon say good bye to her housing woes, thanks to Habitat for Humanity Malawi (HFHM) and their Orphaned and Vulnerable Children (OVC) project.

HFHM partnered with FDH Bank Limited to build a house for 28 year old Charity Madeya from Wetheya Village, Traditional Authority Juma in Mulanje.

Madeya keeps three orphaned children in a small house, whose roof is half gone and when it rains, they have to sleep while standing.

With FDH Bank's K520 000, Madeya and the children will have a new house in a month's time.

HFHM board member, Rabson Kaipa was grateful for FDH Bank's support in building the house.

FDH Bank Head of Corporate Banking, Edward Chilima said this is their way of showing that they are a caring bank.
